

Criteria for Awarding Scholarships for the Advancement of Equal Opportunity

Scholarships for the Successful Completion of Habilitations

- 1. Fulfillment of formal criteria, including membership in MARA;
- 2. Evidence of exceptional academic quality;
- 3. Good to excellent academic achievements in previous studies and exams;
- 4. Prospective submission of the habilitation thesis within a max. of six months from the beginning of the scholarship;
- 5. Conclusive evidence that the work can be submitted at the end of the funding period;
- 6. Relevance to the current research being pursued at Philipps-Universität Marburg; postdoctoral applicants are requested to confirm that they intend to submit their habilitation thesis with Philipps-Universität Marburg; this intention must be confirmed by the reviewer;
- 7. Evaluation of the applicant and the research project in the review. The information in the application must match the information in the review;
- 8. Complete list of publications (please mark the publications, which are relevant for your project. Submitted and accepted (quotable) publications can be listed too, with a suitable note. Publications in process or preparation can't be accepted.):
- 9. Less important: social criteria (children, severe disability, chronic illness, special needs)
