



## Checklist for Arrival and First Weeks

- [ ] Once you have claimed your baggage and gone through customs, go to the Deutsche Bahn Travel Center (Terminal 1, B Concourse, Level 0) and buy a ticket to Marburg Main Train Station ("Marburg Hauptbahnhof").
- [ ] Let the Travel Center give you an itinerary as well.
- [ ] Go to the Regional Train Station (Terminal 1, B Concourse, Level 0) and take the S-Bahn to Frankfurt Main Train Station ("Frankfurt Hauptbahnhof") (approx. 10 - 15 min.). All trains departing from platform 1 (Gleis 1) of the Regionalbahnhof go to the Frankfurt Hauptbahnhof. There change trains to get to Marburg Hauptbahnhof.
- [ ] If you have any problems finding the right train station or platform, ask at the Travel Center in the train stations or call the IUSP phone (+49 - 151 - 70.42.10.02; WhatsApp is also possible).
- [ ] Arrive at Marburg Hauptbahnhof on Arrival Day.
- [ ] Participate in the orientation program. (Get your university account set up, buy groceries, settle into your dorm, and receive your student ID and apply for your visa.)
- [ ] Contact home – Call or email to let your friends and family know you have arrived safely.
- [ ] Explore Marburg using public transportation and by walking around the Oberstadt.
- [ ] Get to know your area. Find the closest:
  - [ ] shops
  - [ ] restaurants
  - [ ] banks
  - [ ] entertainment options
- [ ] Attend German language class.
- [ ] Get to know the other students, learn more about the university, your classes, and life in Marburg.
